

## Daniel 5 (NIV Abridged)

King Belshazzar gave a great banquet for a thousand of his nobles and drank wine with them. While Belshazzar was drinking...he gave orders to bring in the gold and silver goblets Nebuchadnezzar ...had taken from the temple in Jerusalem, so that the king and his nobles...might drink from them. So they brought in the gold goblets... As they drank the wine, they praised the gods of gold and silver...

Suddenly the fingers of a human hand appeared and wrote on the plaster of the wall... The king was so frightened his knees knocked and his legs gave way. The king called out for the...wise men of Babylon...but they could not read the writing...So Belshazzar became even more terrified...

The queen, hearing the voices...came into the banquet hall. "O king... Don't be alarmed!... There is a man in your kingdom who...was found to have...the ability to interpret dreams, explain riddles and solve difficult problems. Call for Daniel, and he will tell you what the writing means."

So Daniel was brought...and the king said, "...If you can read this writing and tell me what it means, you will be...made the third highest ruler in the kingdom." Daniel answered... "You may keep your gifts... I will read the writing for the king and tell him what it means.

"O king, the Most High God gave your father Nebuchadnezzar...greatness...he acknowledged that the Most High God is sovereign over the kingdoms of men...But you...have not humbled yourself...Instead you have set yourself up against the Lord...You had the goblets from his temple brought and...drank wine from them. You praised the gods of silver and gold... But you did not honor the God who holds in his hand your life and all your ways. Therefore he sent the hand that wrote the inscription.

"This is the inscription...MENE, MENE, TEKEL, PARSIN. This is what these words mean: Mene: God has numbered the days of your reign and brought it to an end. Tekel: You have been weighed on the scales and found wanting. Peres: Your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians."

Then at Belshazzar's command, Daniel was clothed in purple, a gold chain was placed around his neck, and he was proclaimed the third highest ruler in the kingdom. That very night Belshazzar...was slain, and Darius the Mede took over the kingdom...
