

## Luke 24:13-41 (abridged)

That same day two of Jesus' followers were walking to the village of Emmaus, seven miles out of Jerusalem. As they walked along they were talking about everything that had happened. Suddenly, Jesus himself came along and joined them and began walking beside them. But they didn't know who he was, because God kept them from recognizing him.

"You seem to be in a deep discussion..." he said. "What are you so concerned about?"

They stopped short, sadness written across their faces. ...Cleopas, replied, "You must be the only person in Jerusalem who hasn't heard about all the things that have happened there...to Jesus, the man from Nazareth. He was a prophet who did wonderful miracles. He was a mighty teacher, highly regarded by both God and all the people. But our ...religious leaders arrested him and...crucified him... That all happened three days ago. Then some women from our group...were at his tomb early this morning, and they came back with an amazing report. They said his body was missing, and they had seen angels who told them Jesus is alive! Some of our men ran out to see, and sure enough, Jesus' body was gone..."
