

Does The Bible Claim To Be From God?

"All Scripture is God-breathed" (2 Tim. 3:16-17 NIV)

1.80% of the books have <u>direct</u> claims

"The Spirit of the Lord speaks through me; his words are on my tongue" (2 Sam 23:2) "This is what the Lord says" or similar phrases occur <u>3800</u> times

"This is a $revelation\ from\ Jesus\ Christ...to\ God's\ servant\ John"\ (Rev.\ 1:1)$

2. All others are written by prophets or <u>quoted by the New</u> <u>Testament</u>

"no prophecy in Scripture ever came from the prophets themselves...It was the Holy Spirit who moved the prophets to speak from God" (2 Peter 1:20-21)

Paul considers Luke's writing to be Scripture (1 Tim. 5:18); Peter considers Paul's writing to be Scripture (2 Peter 3:15-16); Jude considers Peter's writing to be Scripture (Jude 18,19)

Did Jesus Trust The Bible?

1. He said scripture was <u>true</u>

(Jesus) "teach them your word, which is truth." (John 17:17) "Scripture cannot be set aside or cancelled or broken or annulled" (John 10:35 Amp)

2. He quoted & <u>taught</u> from scripture

"Then Jesus quoted passages from the writings of Moses and all the prophets, explaining what all the Scriptures said about himself" (Luke 24:27)

3. He equated <u>His words</u> with scripture

(Jesus) "I tell you the truth...not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from **the Law**." (Matt 5:18 NIV)

"Heaven and earth will disappear, but my words will remain forever" (Matt. 24:35)

Is What We Have Is What Was Written?

Old Testament Evidence:

- 1. Precision of the <u>copyists</u>
- 2. Accuracy vs. the Dead Sea Scrolls (70AD) 95% letter accuracy; <u>99</u>% word accuracy

New Testament Evidence:

- 3. Eyewitness accounts: written early & circulated widely in <u>20-50</u> years
- 4. <u>Early</u> manuscripts 130 AD: parts of John; 200AD: 2/3 of NT; 330AD: entire Bible
- 5. <u>Continuous</u> manuscripts: 5,500 Greek mss, total 25,000
- 6. Accuracy vs. manuscripts: <u>_99.5</u>% Of 20,000 lines only 40 have real variance; no major doctrine

Does Archeology Support The Bible?

Old Testament Evidence:

of biblical sites located, dating back to 2000BC: <u>500</u> David's Palace & Nehemiah's Wall, Jericho, King Solomon's mines, Hittites

New Testament Evidence:

Tomb of Ciaphas, Inscription of Pilate, Residence of Pilate, House of Peter, Jesus boat, Crucified man, Pool of Siloam, Pool of Bethesda, Jacob's well, Luke: refers to 32 countries, 54 cities, dozens of names & titles <u>without error</u>

Is There Internal Evidence?

1. Unique _Quality_

Unity: 66 Books written over 1800 years by over 40 authors

<u>Authority</u>: Universal appeal & influence (2400 languages)

Durability: Surviving persecution and criticism

Story: Matchless message, timeless truth

2. Fulfilled Prophecy

25% of Bible was prophetic when written "If the prophet predicts something...and it does not happen, the Lord did not give the message" (Deut. 18:22)

55-100 about Jesus; 57 about 12 nations & cities, all fulfilled centuries later Israel's destruction and regathering (Hosea 9:17; Jer 31; Ezek 36)

3. Life Changing _ Power_

"For the word of God is full of living power" (Hebrews 4:12)
