Truth #2 – God does not tempt us – James 1:13-14

Truth #3 – God does test us for our good – James 1:2-3

A. Dangerous Flesh – Rom. 7:17

B. Deluding Flesh – Prov. 6:16-19

II. Deliver us from our Enemy!

A. Protect us from underestimation – I Pet. 5:8

B. Protect us for your glory
