What makes this text so challenging?

- 1. It is prohibiting something.
- 2. It is making a distinction of roles in worship according to gender.
- 3. It is out of step with our culture.
- 4. It seems to be out of step with biblical freedoms. Gal. 28
- 5. Contemporary thought dismisses it as a "choose your own adventure."

What helps us with this passage?

- 1. Letting this passage be read with a good "hermeneutical lens."
- 2. Avoiding "creative escape hatches."

3. Accepting that you have a "lens" and asking God to use His word to clarify it!

I. A Call to Protect Learning - 1:11

A. This is a call to Timothy to protect an environment of worship for women.

B. Women are full disciples called to grow.

1. With a serious and attentive spirit.

2. With a joyful submission and partnership to God's authority.

II. A Call to Clarify Burden - 1:12

A. Tale of two very different goals:

- 1. To silence women
- 2. To clarify roles and free women

B. Women are not given the responsibility of preaching.

C. Women are not given the responsibility of spiritual oversight.

III. A Creation Justification - 1:13-14

A. Paul grounds his reasoning in the created order of God.

B. Paul grounds his reasoning in the broken results of violating God's design.

IV. A Creation Affirmation - 1:15

A. Childbearing is not a means of salvation.

B. Paul seems to be referencing a woman's embrace of her unique role and differences from a man.

C. Paul is affirming that a woman who embraces her role draws people to salvation and all its blessings.
