2. Read Ephesians 2:11-12. Who are the “Gentiles” in these verses?
How are they described? How would you describe the distance of the Gentiles from God?
3. What is Paul’s point beginning in verse 13 with “But now”?
4. Read Ephesians 2:13-16. According to these verses what did “the blood of Christ” do for the Gentiles? What kind of “peace” did Jesus provide for us?
5. What is the relationship of Jews and Gentiles according to verses 14-16?
6. Read Ephesians 2:17-18. What is the peace that Jesus brought to the Jews and Gentiles according to these verses?

7. According to this new relationship between Jews and Gentiles, should a follower of Christ be an antisemite? What should a follower of Christ attitude be toward Jewish people?

What new insight or application have you gained from this passage?
