Life Group Questions
The Hope of the Resurrection
1 Corinthians 15:12-22

- 1. Share with your group a memorable Easter.
- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8. What are the essential truths that need to be part of a gospel presentation?
- 3. From 1 Corinthians 15:12, some preach or teach that there is no resurrection of the dead. What does "resurrection of the dead" mean? What makes it different from other views of death?
- 4. If Christ had not been raised from the dead (v.13), what are the various opinions of the empty tomb?
- 5. Read 1 Corinthians 15:14. What should be part of preaching and teaching in the church? What does this look like?
- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 15:16-19. What are the consequences for believers, if there is no resurrection of Jesus Christ and the dead are not raised?
- 7. Read 1 Corinthians 15:20-22. What is the comparison of Adam to Jesus?
- 8. How would you summarize the importance of the resurrection of the dead to the life of the Christian?
