1. What do you think is the contrast for the word “but” in verse 3?
2. Read Ephesians 5:3. What are the conducts and behaviors that should not be named among believers?
3. What do you think it means that these are not “proper among saints”?
4. For these behaviors in verse 3, give some specific examples of what they might look like in the life of a believer.
5. Read Ephesians 5:4. What kind of speech or talk is not fitting for Christians?
  - Do you think means we are not to tell jokes, laugh at things, laugh at people, be sarcastic, be a comedian?
  - What do you think is acceptable and unacceptable talk?
  - Where do you think we error in our Christian culture in our talk?
6. Read Ephesians 5:5. This is a serious statement by Paul. What makes a person to be called “immoral, impure, covetous, or an idolator”?
7. What is your understanding of not having “an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God”?
8. Read Ephesians 5:6-7. What are the “empty words” that can deceive Christians today?

9. What are some examples that you have seen of Christians becoming partakers with the people in verses 3-6?
