- 1. What do you think is the contrast for the word "but" in verse 3?
- 2. Read Ephesians 5:3. What are the conducts and behaviors that should not be named among believers?
- 3. What do you think it means that these are not "proper among saints"?
- 4. For these behaviors in verse 3, give some specific examples of what they might look like in the life of a believer.
- 5. Read Ephesians 5:4. What kind of speech or talk is not fitting for Christians?
 - Do you think means we are not to tell jokes, laugh at things, laugh at people, be sarcastic, be a comedian?
 - What do you think is acceptable and unacceptable talk?
 - Where do you think we error in our Christian culture in our talk?
- 6. Read Ephesians 5:5. This is a serious statement by Paul. What makes a person to be called "immoral, impure, covetous, or an idolator"?
- 7. What is your understanding of not having "an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God"?
- 8. Read Ephesians 5:6-7. What are the "empty words" that can deceive Christians today?

9. What are some examples that you have seen of Christians becoming partakers with the people in verses 3-6?
