Matthew 2:1-23

- 3. The star that the wise men followed has be attributed to many things? What do you think Matthew 24:30 indicates that the star might have been?
- 4. Herod was "rightly disturbed" because of his long history of establishing power and authority. How does his response to Christ inform us of where sin will take you?
- 5. What is the significance of the three gifts the wise men brought to Jesus? How do they paint an amazing picture of worshiping the King?
- 6. God's dramatic angelic protection of His Son is amazing. How does God utilize them to intervene in a timely fashion.
- 7. The spiritual war against Christ rages all throughout this passage. How do we see it specifically in the slaughter of the babies in Bethlehem?
- 8. What new confidence in your King have you gained from this study?
