1. There are with Jesus before He gets to Jerusalem. Read the following verses: Luke 19:1; Matthew 20:2; John 12:1,9; Matthew 21:1. Describe the people who are following Jesus and why they may be following Him.
2. Many people follow Jesus, what are some of the reasons people follow Jesus today?
3. Read Matthew 21:2-3, 6-7. What did Jesus ask the disciples to do? What do you think the disciples may have thought about this request?
4. What did the disciples do after Jesus made His request?
5. This may have been an unusual or difficult request for the disciples. What are the situations or requests of Jesus that makes obedience difficult for you?
6. Read Matthew 21:4-5. According to this passage, what was the purpose of prophecy? What is a prophecy that you are waiting to be fulfilled?
7. Read Matthew 21:8-9. How do you think it felt to be part of this group praising the King and walking to Jerusalem with Jesus?
8. Share with the group the largest worship setting you have been a part of and what you experienced, your thoughts, and feelings while there?

9. How do you think these worshippers of the King on Palm Sunday could become the haters of the King on Good Friday?

10. How do you think followers or worshippers of Jesus today can become those who confess they do not worship or follow Jesus anymore?
