- 1. What comes to mind when you read the word "temptation?" Why is temptation such an awful thing to experience?
- 2. Why do you think the Holy Spirit led Jesus into such a hard place to face such an awful foe? What did this test prove and provide?
- 3. What does this moment reveal about our spiritual enemy, the Devil? What is it that he is after (4:9)?
- 4. What are the three areas of temptations that the Devil tries out on Jesus? Which of these do you think is the easiest for you to fall into? Why?
- 5. What is the danger of seeking short cuts to God's promises? Have you ever been tempted to do so? What was the result?
- 6. Satan comes at us when we are at our weakest (mentally, emotionally and spiritually). What has Jesus done (40 days and nights) to be strong, even though hungry and exhausted?
- 7. How does Jesus use the Word of God in His battle with Satan and temptation?
- 8. How does Jesus' preoccupation with His Father deliver Him from Satan's lies and power?
