Transforming Water to Wine
John 2:1-11

1. Read John 2:1-3. How would you describe the activities and atmosphere of a wedding that lasts for a couple of days? How do you think the wedding attenders/servers/wedding planner/headwaiter/caterer/groom/bride/parents felt when they ran out of wine?

2. Read John 2:4a. What was your first impression when you read that Jesus call his mother “Woman”?

3. If “Woman” was a term of respect, how do we show respect to one another in the church with our words. After some discussion, read 1 Timothy 5:1-2 and share any additional insights from these verses.

4. Read John 2:4b-5. What do you think Mary thought after hearing Jesus’ response “My hour has not yet come”? How did she respond?

How do you respond when Jesus says, “It is not My hour or time to do that for you now”? What does He wants us to do?

5. Read John 2:7-11 What did Jesus do at the wedding? How did the various people (servants, headwaiter, bridegroom, disciples, Mary) respond to this miracle?

6. What do you think the disciples understood about Jesus that made them believe?

7. With this miracle, Jesus demonstrated that He came into this world to transform lives through the gospel. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. How would you describe your life as a new creation and what old things have passed away?

8. Read Romans 12:1-2. How have you seen your thinking transformed as a follower of Christ?

9. Read Matthew 6:19-21 and 2 Corinthians 9:17. How have you seen your giving to the church, missionaries, and ministries transformed as a follower of Christ.

10. Read Ephesian 5: 15-16. How have you seen the use of your time transformed as a follower of Christ?

11. Which area of your life do you see a greater need of transformation?

12. What are some steps you can take this week to be transformed to be more like Christ?
