Life Group Study Questions He Comes Mark 11:7-26

- 2. Read v. 7-10. What was the atmosphere of Jesus' entry to Jerusalem? What do you think the people were expecting?
- 3. Read v.11. What was Jesus' purpose of going into the temple and looking around?
- 4. Read v.12-14. As the disciples listened and watched the fig tree, what were they thinking?
- 5. Read v. 15-19. Describe what Jesus does in the Temple. Why does He do this? What are the different responses to His actions?
- 6. Read v. 20-26. How would you connect the withered fig tree to what has happened? What are the lesson(s) Jesus wants the disciples to learn?
- 7. Jesus was disappointed with what He found in the temple. If Jesus walked into the American Church today, what would disappoint him?
- 8. If Jesus came into our church today, what do you think He would want to find? How are we doing?
